### *Please remember...*

*If you are unable to serve on your scheduled day, it is up to YOU to find someone who will take over for you.*

In this year of our Lord two thousand seventeen we also commemorate the 500th anniversary of the Lutheran Reformation. Martin Luther once asked "what good would it have done if our Lord Christ had died a thousand times but it was not told to me?" The same Lord Jesus who died on the cross and rose from His grave commanded that the Good News of the Gospel go forth and be preached into all the world, and that Trinitarian baptism be extended right along with it by the apostles wherever they went, wherever there were repentant sinners in need of God's grace, and wherever there was water.

In a similar way, what good would it have been if the Lutheran Reformation, which started in Wittenberg at the university there, remained only in Wittenberg or remained only for Luther's lifetime (he died on February 18, 1546)? For various historical, economic, theological, and spiritual reasons—ultimately only God could have defended the Lutheran church—the church body and confessional family, of which we are proudly a part, did survive, grow, spread, and thrive.

One of the main drivers behind this is found in Lutheran church music, particularly the selfless service and musical genius of Johann Sebastian Bach, whose death day (heavenly birthday) we commemorate every year on July 28. Bach is the apex of baroque music (that era lasted from 1600 to 1750—the end date of the musical era coincides with Bach's death). Bach is also the crown of Lutheran church music in fostering solid theology and doctrine by means of music and hymns, and for all ages (Bach worked with singers—including the schoolboys in Leipzig who needed to chant in Latin for the Lutheran services there, he worked with instrumentalists, and organ builders too).

In our own current synodical hymnal (Lutheran Service Book—first published in 2007) there are four hymns that are adorned by Bach's arrangement of a previously composed melody (378—Break Forth O Beauteous, Heavenly Light [originally composed by Schop]; 449—O Sacred Head Now Wounded [Hassler]; 546—O Jesus So Sweet, O Jesus So Mild [a hymnbook from Cologne, Germany]; 657—A Mighty Fortress is Our God [Luther]), and two hymns in our hymnal that had their music composed by Bach himself (414—Tis Good Lord to Be Here; 898—The Ancient Law Departs). Actually, the two composed by Bach himself are one and the same piece, but applied to two different hymns—in fact, the music would have originally gone with an entirely different piece altogether.

Our own congregation, over the last 150 years-plus, has participated in the marriage of Lutheran doctrine and Lutheran church music. We thank God for our organist, the adult choir, the various children's choirs, the brass and other instrumentalists, and the organ itself—all of these are good gifts from God that might offer Him their praise, and lead us as a congregation as we, too, offer praise to the Triune God, our only Savior. This article will conclude with the Collect that is prayed on July 28th, the commemoration of Johann Sebastian Bach:

"Almighty God, beautiful in majesty and majestic in holiness, You have taught us in Holy Scripture to sing Your praises and have given to Your servant Johann Sebastian Bach grace to show forth Your glory in his music. Continue to grant this gift of inspiration to all Your servants who write and make music for Your people, that with joy we on earth may glimpse Your beauty and at length know the inexhaustible richness of Your new creation in Jesus Christ, our Lord, who lives and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever." -Amen.

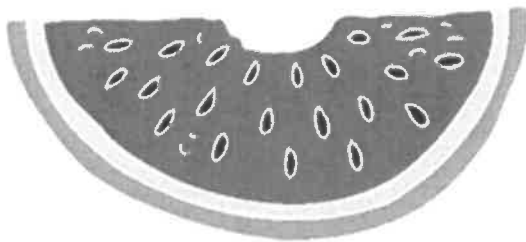
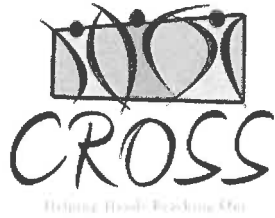

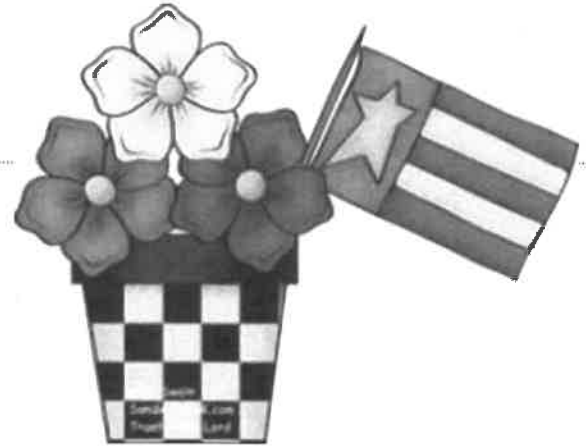
